## **Year 4 Spring Term Activities 2026**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to share with you some key dates for your diaries and the activities Year 4 will be taking part in this term:

### **Anglo-Saxon Workshop – 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> January**

As part of this term's history topic Year 4 will take part in an Anglo-Saxon workshop on 12<sup>th</sup> (4G) and 13<sup>th</sup> (4O) January. The children will be given a chance to interact with artefacts and dress up as Anglo-Saxons.

### **Bikeability – Level 1 – 14<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> January**

Highfield has registered with Surrey to offer the Level 1 Bikeability course to Year 4 on **14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> January 2026**. This course is all based on the school grounds and looks at developing cycling skills and safety on a bike. The School Office has previously sent information regarding signing up to the course.
