We are excited to share with you some key dates for your diaries and the activities Year 6 will be taking part in this term.

### **Bikeability Level 2 (Week Beginning 26<sup>th</sup> January) and Try It Out (12<sup>th</sup> January)**

On the **week beginning 26<sup>th</sup> January** Year 6 will be able to take part in the **Bikeability Level 2** course at school.
